


Our Story

This annual brunch, held the first Saturday in December, supports the LGBTQ+ Student Success Fund. To date these events have raised over \$150,000! These funds directly support LGBTQ+ students with scholarships and emergency grants. Some of the emergency situations include unplanned medical, transportation, equipment, housing, and tuition expenses that would jeopardize their college dreams. The scholarships and emergency grants are managed and awarded throughout the year by the SPSCC Foundation.

This continues in 2024, when we increaced our partnerships by 73% in 2024. These dollars go directly to helping students. No event costs come out of our partnerships.

Our partners demonstrate their support for SPSCC and the diversity that makes the College and this community special. SPSCC has one of the highest percentages of students that identify as LGBTQ+. The community's show of support for them is powerful.
